**CITA - Christ is the Answer Mission**

### **Glory Mansion**

Cocoa Beach: Glory Mansion (under the umbrella of WEGO - Worldwide Evangelical Gospel Outreach Ministries) is a home for women who desire to make life-style changes with the Lord’s help. GM provides a 12-month discipleship program as well as daily devotions, and daily life skills

### **His Place Ministries and the Cold Night Shelter**

### **Hope Ministries**
